These are groups who would rarely meet, who would rarely set foot in a theatre and have little or no experience of Shakespeare.

Alongside scenes from Shakespeare's Romeo & Juliet you will hear the participants own stories of love and romance. You might already be familiar with the most famous story of love at first sight, this is your chance to come and share in the excitement of first love on Blackpool's Prom!
